Entries and Relays

- Swimmers must be registered financial members of a Masters' club at close of entry,
 1st February 2020, unless entering as a one-off 'Guest' competitor.
- Competitors may enter in a maximum of five (5) individual events which may include two (2) postal events.
- Postal events must be swum between 1st January and 1st February 2020. Results must be submitted to the MSQ website by 5.00pm on 1st Feb. Completed Postal Forms should be given to Club Captains for later reconciliation.
- A postal swim must be done under the supervision of a club official with knowledge
 of the rules of swimming to verify that strokes and turns were executed in
 accordance with Masters' Rules. The supervisor must sign the Entry Form.
- Entries are to be submitted via Entry Manager located on the 'Members' Forum' of the MSQ website. Go to http://forum.mastersswimmingqld.org.au and then choose the 'Quick Entry' option. Entries close at 5.00pm, 1st February 2020.
- All entrants must pay the nomination fees online as directed by Entry Manager, linking to 'How to pay online'. Payment may be made either by card or Pay Pal.
- Relay entries must be submitted via Entry Manager by 8th February 2020. Relays are to be swum in the order swimmers are nominated. New entries won't be accepted on the day, but any changes (due to illness) may be made before 11.00am on race day.
- Swimmers must enter one individual event to be eligible for a relay. Entrants may only compete once in each relay event. Clubs may submit as many teams as they wish for each age group, but team points will only be allocated for the 'A' relay team.

Other details

- There is a partially covered grandstand on the western side of the pool. There's also room for your own shade gazebos around the pool, but there's no grass so bring weights instead of tent pegs.
- Warm-up will begin at 8.45am and competition at 9.30am. Warm-up lanes will be allocated according to stroke choice so please abide by the signage. Lane 8 has been allocated as a warm-up and warm-down lane while the competition is in progress.
- Timekeepers will be required throughout day and everyone's cooperation will be greatly appreciated.
- Food and refreshments will be on sale at the BLK Pool's canteen sandwiches, wraps, pies, sausage rolls, chips etc. as well as tea, coffee, sports drinks and soft drinks.
- Please download individual programs from the MSQ website before the meet. Each club will receive one printed program.
- Parking: Please park in the Western Carpark. Take the fourth entrance from Sports
 Drive. This leads to the Western Carpark. The map shows how to walk around to the
 pool. The Centre will have other events on that day, so please do not park out the
 front.
- Multi-class swimmers are welcome to compete. Disability Certificates are to be handed to the Chief Referee before the commencement of the meet.

Presentation of awards will take place around the pool. Please join us for a drink, and the barbeque. Awards will be presented to (1) Age Group winners; (2) the club with 6 or fewer competitors with the highest average number of points; and (3) the club with 7 or more competitors with the highest average number of points.
