## **Entries and Relays**

- Swimmers must be registered financial members of a Masters' club at close of entry, 1st February, 2019, unless entering as a one-off 'Guest' competitor.
- Competitors may enter in a maximum of five (5) individual events which may include two (2) postal events.
- Postal events must be swum between 1st January and 1st February 2019. Results must be submitted to the MSQ website by 5.00 pm on 1st Feb. Completed Postal Forms should be given to Club Captains for later reconciliation.
- Entries are to be submitted via Entry Manager located on the 'Members' Forum' of the MSQ website http://forum.mastersswimmingqld.org.au before 5.00 pm, 1st February, 2019.
- All entrants should pay for the meet directly through Entry Manager using PayPal or a credit card.
   Please note that once you have entered, you will need to click on 'Pay Pal' and this will let you enter your credit card number, even if you do not have a PayPal account.
- Relay entries must be submitted via Entry Manager by the closing date. Relays are to be swum
  in the order swimmers are nominated. New entries won't be accepted on the day, but any
  changes may be made before 11.00 am on race day.
- Swimmers may only compete in one relay. Clubs may submit as many teams as they wish for each age group, but team points will only be allocated for the 'A' relay team.

#### Other details

- Warm up will begin at 8.45 am and competition at 9.30 am. Warm up lanes will be allocated
  according to stroke choice so please abide by the signage. Lane 9 has been allocated as a warm
  up and warm down lane while the competition is in progress.
- Clubs will be allocated a specific lane for time-keeping duties. Please be aware that time-keepers
  will be required throughout the day and everyone's cooperation will be greatly appreciated.
- Food and refreshments will be on sale at the Miami Swim Club's canteen.
   If you wish to buy espresso coffee, it is available at the Miami Aquatic Centre kiosk at a very reasonable price.
- As an environmentally aware club we ask that you download individual programs from the MSQ website before the meet as printed programs will only be available for officials.
- There is adequate parking at or near the pool.
- Multi Class [MC] swimmers are welcome to compete.
- Multi Class [MC] Swimmers may nominate under their classification if they wish.
- Multi Class swimmers compete in their own right. There will not be separate heats (unless numbers allow for that) for MC swimmers, however, the results will be recognised as MC results.
- Non-MC competitors with a medical disability must forward the current Medical Disability Certificate endorsed by a registered medical practitioner. Forms available from the <u>Masters</u> <u>Swimming Australia</u>

#### Presentation of awards

After the relays the fun, rejuvenation and rehydration will take place at 'Lane 11'— the grassy area south of the entry kiosk. Join us for a drink (or two) from the bar, and/or the barbeque.

- 1. Age Group winners;
- 2. The club with 8 or fewer competitors with the highest average number of points; and
- 3. The club with 9 or more competitors with the highest average number of points.
